

## Workshop in Reconstructive Surgery

### Data and administrative Sheet

Criteria for selecting the participants

- a) WACS Graduated doctors-surgeons or FCS surgeons in training
- b) Proven Interest for the plastic surgery
- c) Availability to follow the program
- d) Non-remuneration
- e) English and/or French speaking depending upon the teaching language.

The workshop is extensively given over a limited of 5 working days.

The workshop is built upon theoretical and practical teaching in operating room. Those two complementary didactic methods are key factors to success. The training takes place in a hospital provided with enough operations rooms in order not to disrupt too much other surgical activities. It also requires a qualified service of anaesthesia.

The workshop is sanctioned by a written test. No diploma is delivered but surgeons receive certificates for participating.

The participants will be introduced to:

- Establishing indication for surgery and choose the simplest techniques regarding the given pathology,
- Acquiring notions of basic, simple but effective surgical procedures in the field of the reconstructive surgery,
- Preventing operating complications including during anaesthesia.
- Ensure follow-up of the patients those requiring of the physiotherapy and pain management.
- Learning and applying the World Health Organization (WHO) integrated management for Emergency and Essential Surgical Care (IMEESC Toolkit)

### Administration
